FOR GROWN-UPS

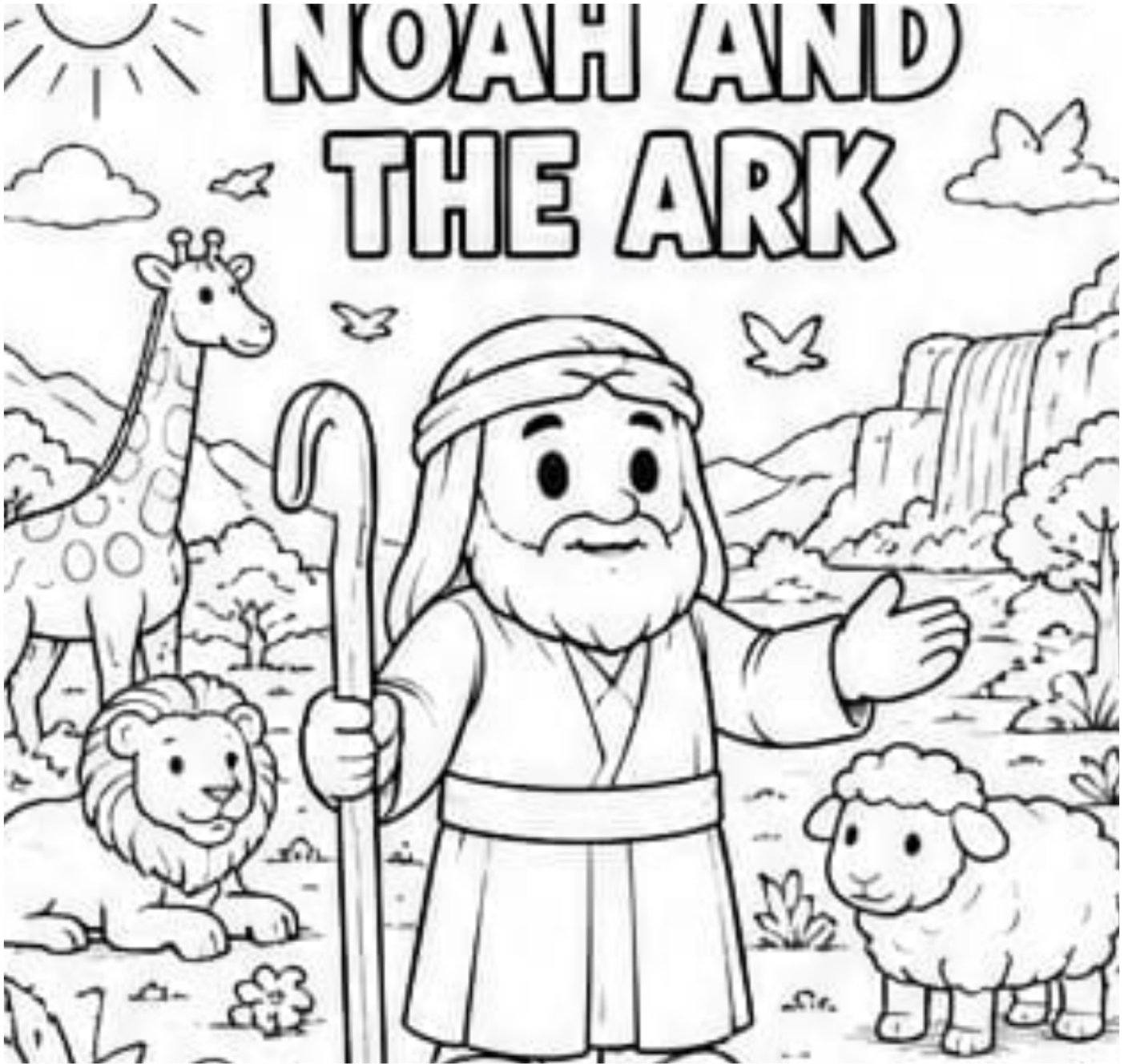
Read one page a day. Say the words out loud, then let your child colour the picture and tell the story back to you.

4. NOAH AND HIS FAMILY ENTER THE ARK

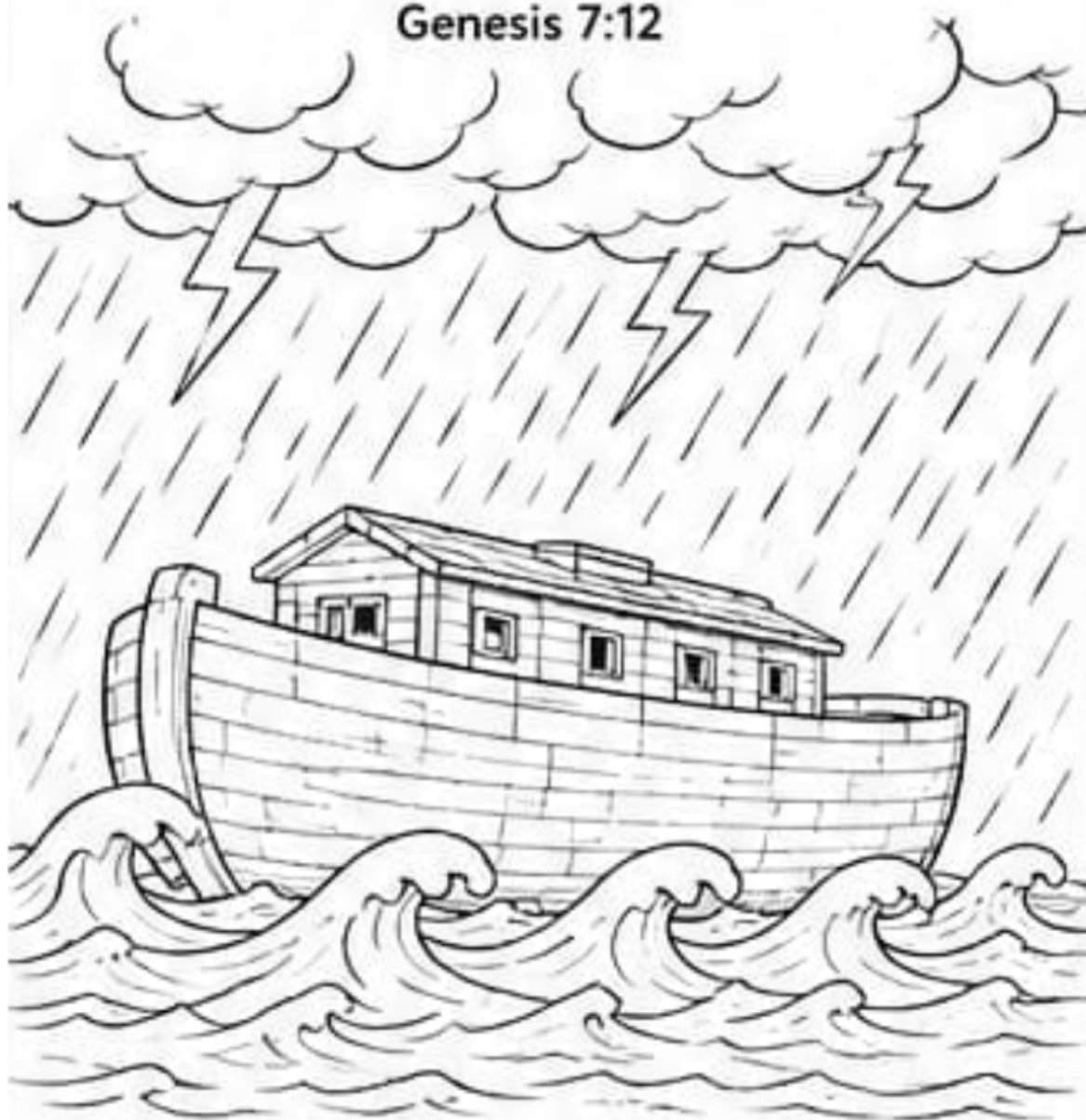
Genesis 7:7

5. THE RAIN CAME

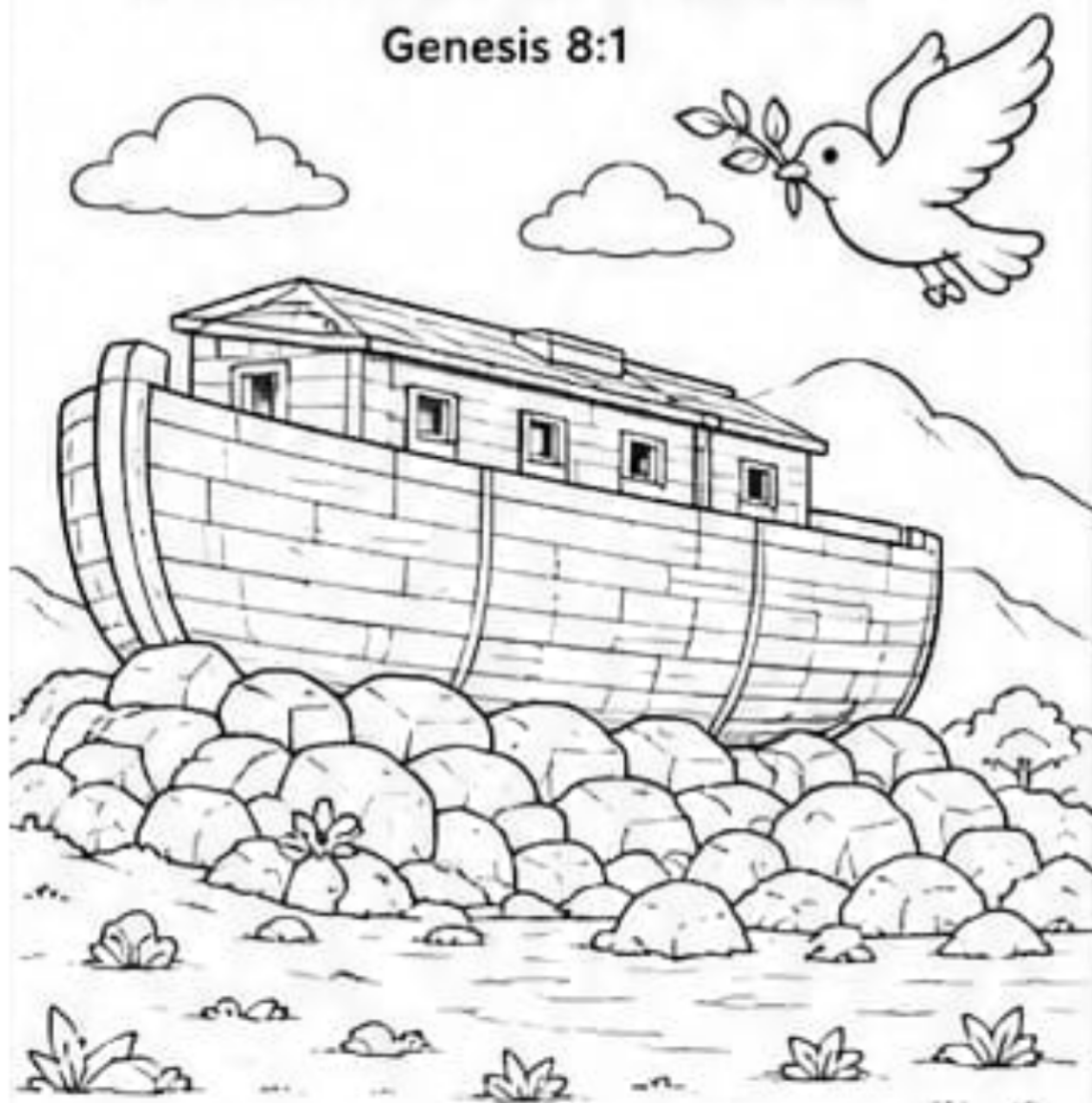
Genesis 7:12

7. THE DOVE RETURNS
